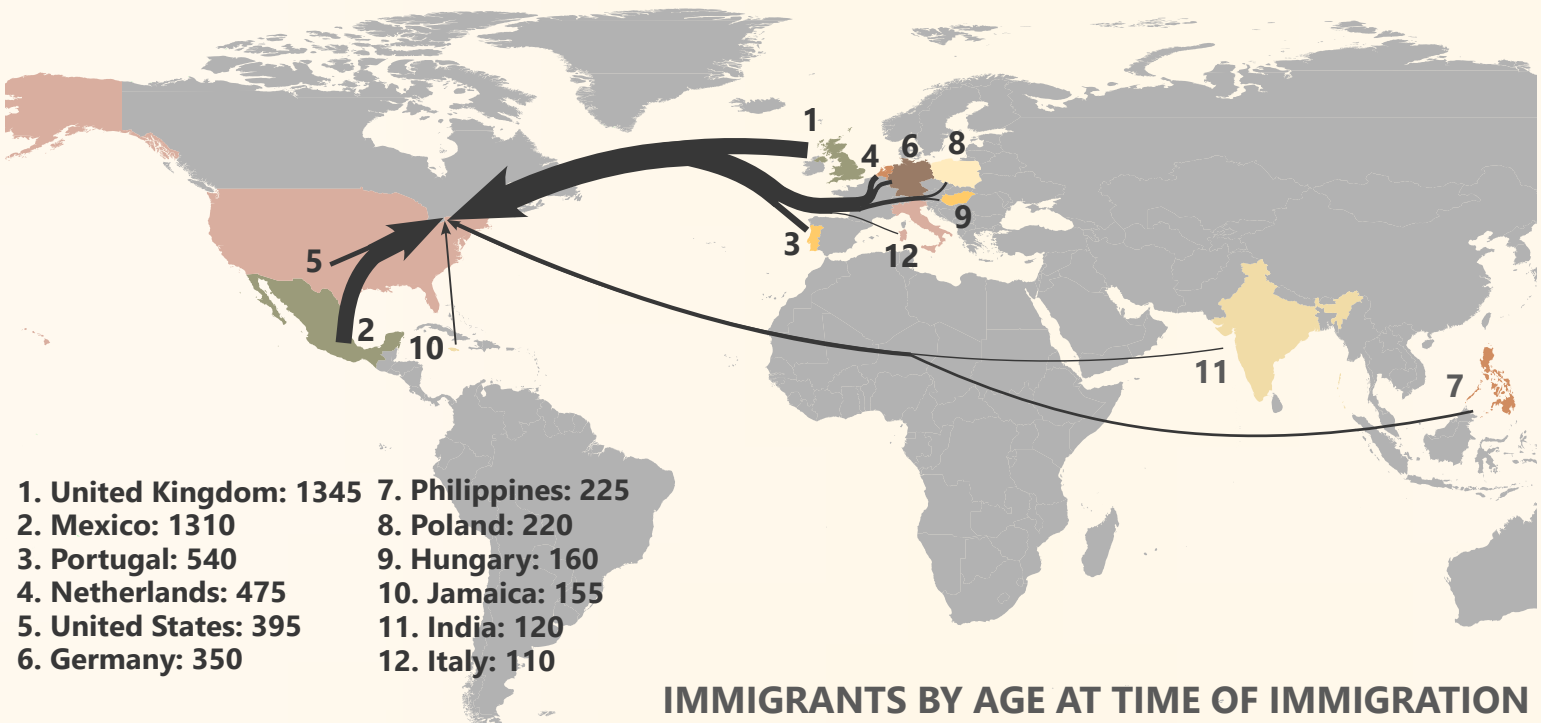

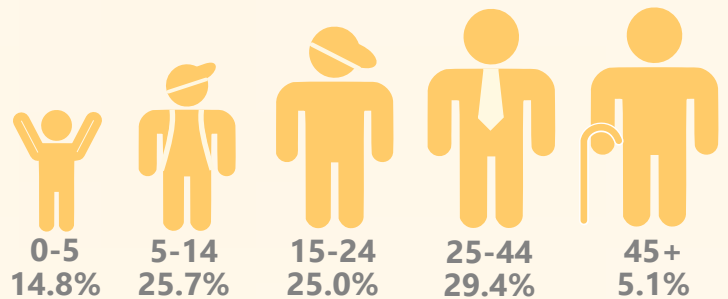
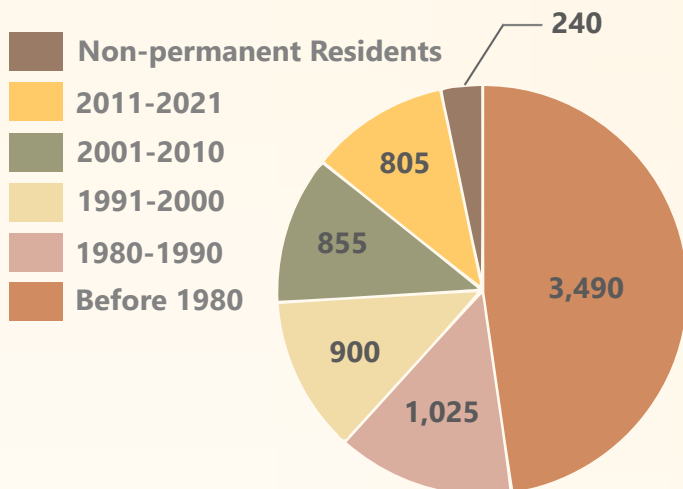

TOP ORIGINATING COUNTRIES FOR IMMIGRANTS TO NORFOLK COUNTY

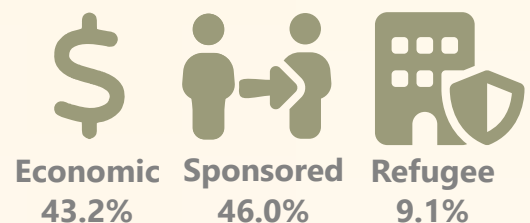


IMMIGRANTS BY AGE AT TIME OF IMMIGRATION

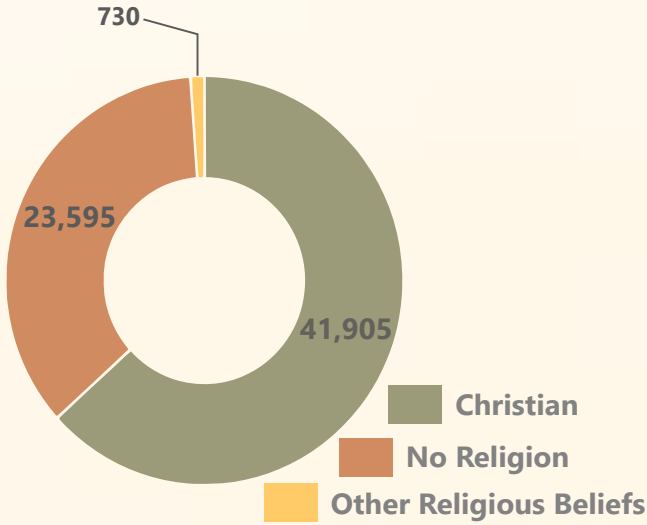
YEAR OF IMMIGRATION



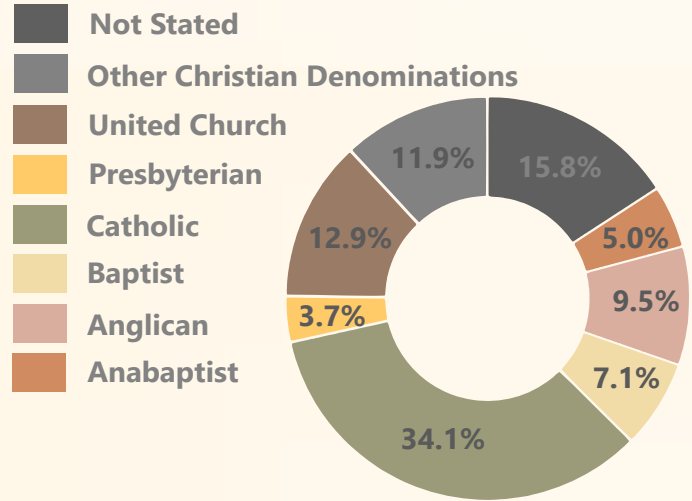
IMMIGRANTS BY ADMISSION TYPE



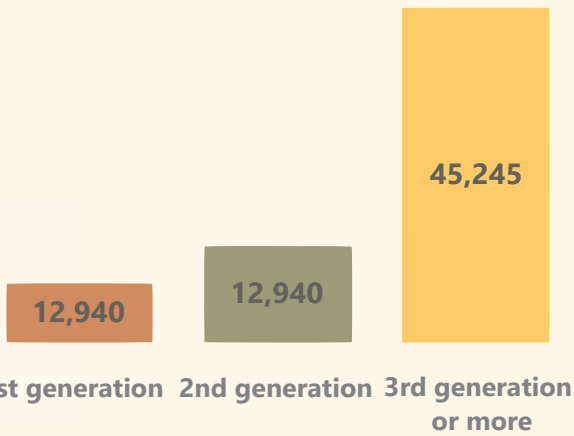
NORFOLK'S RELIGIOUS BELIEFS



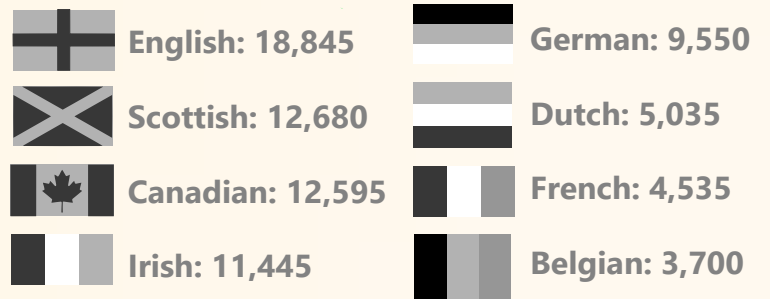
BREAKDOWN OF CHRISTIAN DENOMINATIONS
