#### **New Accommodation Rates**

The Ministry of Long-Term Care has shared that there will be an increase in accommodation charges.

Basic Accommodation – On July 1, 2024, the maximum co-payment that Residents pay for basic accommodation in Long-Term Care (LTC) homes will increase by \$1.63 per day from \$65.32 per day to \$66.95 per day, consistent with the recent inflationary increases. This will help cover the rising cost of meals and accommodation.

Preferred Accommodation – The maximum charges will also be increasing for Residents admitted to newer preferred accommodation beds on or after July 1, 2024. The premium charged for private accommodation will increase by \$0.70 from \$28.00 to \$28.70 per day.
