# 1. Call to Order / Welcome / Declaration of Pecuniary Interest / Review of Agenda

# 7. Correspondence:

- 1. Correspondence from Richard Hareychuk (support for Ukraine). If he is looking for financial assistance, we will require more information. We should get a sample of what he has. We can circulate his info in our newsletter. If he has a particular product, we can make it available to our members for pick up in the BIA office.
- 2. Beat Bard Bits-Joy Allgood and Dave Kent. Looking for Production sponsorship at a summer outdoor production being held over the Civic Holiday weekend in the bandshell at the Lynnwood Arts. They are in Friendship Festival's advertising. Les will follow up with Joy to let her know that it may be a little noisy with our Friday Night event going at the same time.

### 8. Committee Reports

**Executive Committee:** No meeting held.

**Committee of the Whole**: Meeting was held on Friday May 26 at 8:30 AM. Items from the notes will be discussed under Other Business. Committee of the Whole report was received as information prior to this meeting. Next meeting date is Friday June 23, 2023 at 8:30 AM.

#### 9. Other Business / Round Table

- Drive through Art Gallery. Banners specific to Argyle Street will be installed on both sides of that street. Also, banners will be placed between the trees on Lynwood Arts front lawn and down Culver Street (Bev's Chip Wagon). Plaid banners will be placed down Norfolk Street. Since we have a limited # of banners this year, a mix of migrant workers themed banners will be included.
- **9b** Hanging baskets went up last week. Installed on every other pole to avoid cameras. Purchased two-sided banners to go on every other pole where there is no hanging basket. They are on the street side of the pole.
- Occidence spoke of doing 2 corner windows of his business with TVs to advertise; would there be any objection? He currently puts items in the window that creates interest. We agreed it's a great idea. Les will check if it's ok re flashing, scrolling, brightness, etc. If approved, we can add into our newsletter. Blue Elephant, Venture Norfolk, and the Simcoe and District Chamber of Commerce are examples of who has this type of advertising.
- Planters are planted. Hockley's Landscaping is watering the planters and hanging baskets. Les still checking for planter options. Joe suggested contacting the Delhi BIA for information on their planters. Eising's is small compared to Tillsonburg planter.

- Downtown Friday Nights: Next week will be the 2<sup>nd</sup> event. Good number of volunteers including the 9e Simcoe Composite Cheerleading Team. Need help at Pond & Argyle due to car show. Couple of more vendors signed up. No food trucks. Good for JK's, Tito's, Golden Restaurant, and Bev's Chip Wagon. Suggest telling them this is a good opportunity for them to "cash in" by perhaps coming up with a Friday Night Special. JK's has applied for a patio; expecting to hear very soon. Can be barricaded off by cement block with pressure treated posts. Clarence has a large quantity in his basement and has offered them to us. Can also store in the back alley when not in use. 9f Hot dog stand: no longer at Canadian Tire. Is there an opportunity to have one in downtown? 9g Ensure with Norfolk County Roads Dept. that we have enough barricades for Argyle and side streets. Need something more visible on Norfolk as public didn't realize it was closed. Bill Cridland has assured us
- that there will be more barricades available. Lyndsey suggested that we email Bill Cridland directly for requests.
- Downtown Friday Night: Les sent out the budget. Lots of comments about close proximity to food, 9h shade. July event will have Corvette Club of Hamilton, Indulge Ice Cream, Riversyde 83, and hopefully Judd's strawberries.
- Two donation requests. One from Friendship Festival which we donated to last year. If we do donate, we 9i need to be sure that they are not doing anything on the Downtown Friday Night that we have already arranged. Les said that we were one of the sponsors for the community stage last year. This year we can sponsor the Opening Ceremonies. Les is checking this with Tony Duclos.
- 9j Gazebo: Lyndsey to contact Bill Cridland to request brush cleanup near gazebo. The County was asked last fall, but nothing has been done.
- 9k Grant opportunities: There is a grant opportunity from Festivals Ontario that would assist with the costs for four of the Friday Night events next year. The deadline to apply is October 6, 2023, for the 2024 events. Trillium foundation has an opportunity for capital grants. Minimum \$10K. Cannot buy property ie. the former Esso station. Also, Venture Norfolk has not reviewed our grant application there, but Les has been in contact with them.
- 91 Vacant property occupied by Handy Henry's. Could it have a hot dog stand for the summer as an outreach program between BIA and street people? Joe has been in contact with the former hot dog vendor from Canadian Tire that retired.
- Financial projection: We need to give thought to where we can find additional funding. County has notified 9m us that June 1st was date for levy installment and next one is November. We need it sooner than that, and the County will check that if once the installment is approved, could it be paid out to us one month later.
